

## "L" PROGRAM AUDITORS

This is an excellent education for anyone wanting to learn more about dressage who does not intend to become an L graduate or a judge. We have limited space for auditors, and we expect them fill. Auditors will be seated behind the participants in the room/arena, are expected to silently observe during the presentations, and will have the opportunity to ask questions via note cards that will be given to the instructor at breaks. Auditors will be able to see, hear, and learn, like the participants. They will not have access to Participant L Program material through the L Program website. Handouts will be sent electronically to auditors for printing. Lunch will be included. We will not take walk-ins. You must pre-register. To sign up, complete the form on our webpage:

The cost for auditing is \$100 per weekend. There is no discount for attending only one day or a partial day. Attendance for the full weekend is recommended because the classroom teaching relates to what you will see in the live riding demonstrations on Sunday. Auditor fees are not refundable, but they are transferable. If you are unable to come, you may find someone to take your spot.

Two USDF University credits will be awarded to each silent auditor (one credit per day of the session). Silent auditors must sign the waivers, auditor roster, include their USDF number, and be a current USDF Member (PM,GM, or EM) in order to receive University credit. After each session, the rosters are sent to the USDF office for the credits to be awarded.

We will use the COVID-19 best practices most appropriate for each activity. All USDF education events and activities must comply with state and local requirements. In an effort to minimize the risk of spreading COVID-19, facilities and organizers may impose requirements more restrictive than those mandated by state and local authorities. If a facility/venue imposes protocols that are more restrictive than state and local authorities, the more restrictive protocols must be followed. You may be asked to provide proof of COVID vaccination or a negative test.
